### Call for Film Submissions Opens August 29

After a successful inaugural year, <u>CAPA</u>, in partnership with the <u>Drexel Theatre</u> and <u>Gateway</u> <u>Film Center</u> and additional support from community partner <u>Film Columbus</u>, is proud to announce the 2023 <u>Cinema Columbus Film Festival</u>.

"Cinema Columbus provides an opportunity for the film lovers of Columbus and beyond to experience works that will spark curiosity, conversation, and a deeper understanding of the world through independent cinema," stated festival coordinator Molly Kreuzman.

"Cinema Columbus is the best thing to happen to Ohio since the invention of flight (which, if you didn't know, was invented in Ohio)," shared filmmaker Colin West (*Linoleum*, which opened the 2022 festival). "Bringing together local heroes and international superstars, Cinema Columbus is the perfect mix of Midwest charm and industry fervor. Even after just one year, Cinema Columbus has become the keystone that makes Columbus a premiere destination for filmmakers and fans of film alike."

Cinema Columbus 2023 will begin accepting entries August 29 in the following categories:

Narrative Feature – A narrative, animated, or experimental film 41 minutes or more in length.

Documentary Feature – A documentary film 41 minutes or more in length.
Narrative Short – A narrative, animated, or experimental film 40 minutes or less in length.
Documentary Short – A documentary film 40 minutes or less in length.

Filmmakers can enter their films and pay the corresponding entry fee through <a href="https://filmfreeway.com/CinemaColumbus">https://filmfreeway.com/CinemaColumbus</a>. Films with 50% or more footage shot in Ohio are eligible to submit under a reduced local entry fee. Submission deadlines are as follows:

Early-bird submission: August 29 – October 9 Regular submission: October 10 – November 6 Extended submission: November 7 – 27 Last call submission: November 28 – December 18

Submissions will be screened and judged by a local panel of film experts, and films selected to participate in Cinema Columbus 2023 will be notified on or before February 1, 2023.

Selected films, a full schedule of events, and details on how to purchase tickets will be announced in 2023. Additional venues may be added.
